

HAVE YOU DONE EVERYTHING YET?

A REMINDER!

WHAT TO DO:

Throughout the hurricane season, keep all storm materials in good working order and test repeatedly. Once a storm is approaching, take the following steps to protect your home.

OUTSIDE:

- Board up windows with plywood or close storm shutters
- Trim trees and shrubs around home and tie down small trees and fence
- Turn off propane tanks and secure items (outdoor furniture, grills, etc.)

INSIDE:

- Take detailed photos of your contents
- Secure important documents in waterproof container
- Fill bathtub with water for cleaning and sanitation (use bleach)
- Prepare an emergency kit (see details below)

BASIC CHECKLIST:

Make sure have the following items on hand at home:

- 7-day supply of non-perishable food
- Hand operated can opener
- Disposable plates, cups, other utensils
- 5 Gallons of Drinking Water Per Person for 7 Days
- First aid kit and medications
- Toilet Paper, Paper Towels, Garbage Bags
- Soap, Hand Sanitizer, Tooth Brush and Tooth Paste
- Duct Tape
- Flashlights with Extra Batteries
- Battery Powered Radio with Extra Batteries
- Cell Phone with Extra Charger
- Baby Items (Formula, Diapers, Wipes, Bottles, etc.)
- Cash
- Vehicles with Full Gas Tanks
- Pet Supplies
