All Shelters in The Bahamas are activated as of 10 am Friday, July 31st 2020.

WHAT TO BRING:

- ✓ **Bottle water**
3 gallons per person for 3 days
- ✓ **Food**
Non-perishable packaged or canned goods
*Don't forget to take a can opener
- ✓ **Medication**
At least 2 weeks supply because pharmacies might not be open
- ✓ **Flashlight with batteries**
- ✓ **Battery-powered Radio with extra batteries**
- ✓ **Clothing**
One complete change of clothing and comfortable footwear
- ✓ **Bedding**
Blankets, sleeping bags, small pillows
- ✓ **First Aid Supplies**
Bring a first aid kit in case of an emergency.
- ✓ **Hygiene Items**
A toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, etc
- ✓ **Personal Information**
Store your important personal documents in a waterproof bag
- ✓ **Cash**
Bring cash for emergency purposes after the storm
- ✓ **Small games for entertainment**
